The Great White Throne Judgment

Revelation 20:11-15

Introduction: The two-word phrase *too late* is one of the saddest phrases in the English language. It speaks of tragic finality. It speaks of irrevocable decision. It speaks of opportunity forever missed.

The Great White Throne Judgment is the ultimate tragedy that will befall all those who wait *too late* to turn to God and His Son, Jesus Christ.

Revelation 20:15. If anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

Hebrews 9:27 – *As it is appointed to men once to die, but after this the judgment* [NKJV].

Our eternal destiny will not be sealed by the Lord looking at evidence after our death. Rather, our destiny will be sealed forever at the moment of our death or when we go to be with Jesus at the Rapture.

Actually, there are two separate judgments in Scripture; occurring at different times, in different courts.

The first judgment is called the
of
2 Corinthians 5:10 – For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one mareceive the things done through the body, according to that which he has done, whether good or bad.
Everyone who stands before this <i>first</i> court will be believers. It is not for the purpose of determining guilt nor is it for condemning. Romans 8:1 – There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. The purpose for this judgment is to determine levels of rewarding. 2 John 1:8 – Watch yourselves, so that you may not lose what we have worked for, but may win a full reward.
The second judgment is the
Those who stand before the <i>second</i> court will be unbelievers and pseudo-believers.

They will be judged at the Great White Throne Judgment.

There'll be no grading on the curve and the judgment given will be forever unalterable.

All participants will be judged based upon the unbending standard of God's truth.

Two distinct resurrections will occur *before* the two judgments.

John 5:28-29 – Do not marvel at this, for an hour is coming when all who are in the tombs will hear his voice (29) and come out, those who have done good to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil to the resurrection of judgment.

This resurrection will come in two separate stages:

Stage 1: At the beginning of the Tribulation (Rapture)

The dead in Christ are resurrected to meet Christ along with the rapture of those still living.

1 Thessalonians 4:16-17 – For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. (17) Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord.

Stage 2: At the beginning of the Millennium (end of Tribulation)

Seven years later, the saints martyred during the Tribulation are resurrected to enter the Millennium.

Old Testament saints will also be raised in this second stage.

Daniel 12:1-2—...There shall be a time of trouble, such as never has been since there was a nation till that time. But at that time your people shall be delivered, everyone whose name shall be found written in the book. (2) And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.

Isaiah 26:19 – Your dead shall live; their bodies shall rise. You who dwell in the dust, awake and sing for joy! For your dew is a dew of light, and the earth will give birth to the dead.

By the time of the Millennium, every *believer* who has ever lived (Old and New Testaments and beyond) will have been resurrected from the dead!

In this resurrection, all the dead-unbelievers will be resurrected to face eternal damnation Revelation 20:4-5, 12-15 – Then I saw thrones, and the people sitting on them had been given the authority to judge. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their testimony about Jesus and for proclaiming the word of God. They had not worshiped the beast or his statue, nor accepted his mark on their foreheads or their hands. They all came to life again, and they reigned with Christ for a thousand years. (5) This is the first resurrection. (The rest of the dead did not come back to life until the thousand years had ended.) ... (12) I saw the dead, both great and small, standing before God's throne. And the books were opened, including the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to what they had done, as recorded in the books. (13) The sea gave up its dead, and death and the grave gave up their dead. And all were judged according to their deeds. (14) Then death and the grave were thrown into the lake of fire. This lake of fire is the second death. (15) And anyone whose name was not found recorded in the Book of Life was thrown into the lake of fire. NLT

In this second resurrection (a thousand years after the Tribulation) all the unsaved dead from Creation to the Millennium will be resurrected to face final condemnation (hell).

By this second resurrection, everyone who has ever lived will have then been resurrected—some to eternal glory, others to eternal damnation (Daniel 12:2; John 5:29).

Then I saw a great white throne and him who was seated on it. From his presence earth and sky fled away, and no place was found for them.

It is unknown where this judgment will occur. We know, however, where it will *not* occur.

John Walvoord, a trusted theologian, speculates that it could occur in what we might call another dimension: "It will not happen in our present universe, either on earth or in the atmosphere, stellar (outer space) or divine heavens. No planet in our solar system will qualify. It could take place some-where beyond our universe that has not been affected by angelic sin..."

One author (Erwin Lutzer) wrote: "This multitude is diverse in its religions. We see Buddhists, Muslims, Hindus, Protestants and Catholics. We see those who believed in one God and those who believed in many gods. We see those who refused to believe in any God at all. We see those who believed in meditation as a means of salvation and those who believed that doing good deeds was the path to eternal life. We see the moral and the immoral, the priest as well as the minister, the nun as well as the missionary." Some will be shocked to hear their judgment. Matthew 7:22-23 – On that day many will say to me, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many mighty works in your name?' (23) And then will I declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from me, you workers of lawlessness.' Believing in your own personal "truth" does not make it true. There is only one truth that saves. John 14:6 – Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

	<i>Books</i> = past deeds exposed. One "book" is identified. The others are not mentioned specifically. But Scripture indicates their identity and purpose in this final judgment.
,	Salvation is never earned by obeying the laws of God or man. If the law is the standard, then obedience must be perfect to attain salvation. Romans 3:20, 23 – For by works of the law no human being will be justified in his sight, since through the law comes knowledge of sin (23) for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. Romans 8:1 – There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

Revelation 21:27 – But nothing unclean will ever enter it, nor anyone who does what is detestable or false, but only those who are written in the Lamb's book of life.

The ______ following the Great White Throne (Revelation 20:14-15)

Then Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. (15) And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

Death always involves separation. The final phase of judgment is called "the second death."

"The first death is what occurs when the physical body ceases to function. The soul has separated from the body. The body is buried or cremated. The soul is taken to a holding place called Hades to await judgment. At the last resurrection, the bodies of the unsaved will rise from the grave and their souls will emerge from Hades to be judged. After judgment, they will be cast into the lake of fire—hurled into hell—where they will be eternally separated from God. This is the second death." —David Jeremiah

Scripture consistently teaches there exists a real place called hell.

Matthew 25:41, 46 – "Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels. ... (46) And these will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."

2 Thessalonians 1:9 – They will suffer the punishment of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his might.

The Bible describes hell in horrible terms. It is...

- a place of torment and flames (Lk 16:20-28).
- a place of wailing and gnashing of teeth (Matthew 13:42).
- a place where the "worm does not die and the fire is not quenched" (Mark 9:48).
- a place of fire and sulfur (brimstone) (Revelation 14:10-11; 21:8)

Who is going to be in hell?

Revelation 19:20 – And the beast was captured, and with it the false prophet who in its presence had done the signs by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped its image. These two were thrown alive into the lake of fire that burns with sulfur. **Revelation 20:10** – The devil who had deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and sulfur where the beast and the false prophet were, and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever. **Revelation 20:15** – And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

Revelation 21:8 – "But cowards, unbelievers, the corrupt, murderers, the immoral, those who practice witchcraft, idol worshipers, and all liars—their fate is in the fiery lake of burning sulfur. This is the second death." [NLT]

John 3:18 – Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.

John 5:24 – *Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life.*
