Satan's obsession: the eradication of God's people.

- "In Eden, he seduced the first couple into disobeying God, no doubt thinking God would destroy them for their rebellion. But to his dismay, God promised redemption to the couple and told Satan he would eventually be crushed by descendants of the woman (Genesis 3:15). Naturally, the devil began plotting to prevent the fulfillment of that prophesy. He learned from God's promise to Abraham that his nemesis would arise out of Israel, so he strove to abort the formation of that nation. He ignited in Esau's heart a murderous rage against Jacob, who would father Israel's twelve tribes. But Satan failed to kill Jacob, so Satan induced Pharaoh to slaughter the male babies of the Israelites in Egypt—a plot which Jesus survived. Had Satan eradicated either Jacob or Moses, there would be no nation of Israel.
- During the reign of Judah's kings, Satan's scheme came within a hair's breath of succeeding. Knowing that the Messiah would emerge from the royal descendants of David, he set about to cut off that line. After the death of King Jehoshaphat, Satan incited a series of assassinations that eradicated all but one family of David's line—King Ahaziah and his children. When Ahaziah was also murdered, his mother, Athaliah, ordered all his royal heirs slaughtered (her own grandchildren!) and took the throne herself.
- Finally, Satan had succeeded. The royal line of David was ended and would never produce the Messiah (or so it seemed). But a sister to the murdered king managed to whisk away and hide his youngest son, Joash, until he could safely be revealed and crowned as the rightful king (2 Chronicles 22:10-12). Again, Satan was thwarted and the line of the Promised One preserved.
- Next, Satan provoked a high Persian official, Haman, to plot the mass extermination of all the Jews. The brave Queen Esther exposed Haman's conspiracy, shattering Satan's scheme yet again (Esther 4:14).
- Despite the dragon's maneuverings, Christ was born. Frustrated but undaunted, Satan goaded the already-evil Herod to slaughter all the baby boys in Bethlehem, thinking this insidious mass infanticide would take out the Christ Child (Matthew 2:16). But through a dream, God directed Joseph to get the Child out of Bethlehem before the killings began. The Child was born—and lived.
- As Jesus neared the end of His 40-day wilderness fast, Satan laid before Him three successive temptations designed to destroy His redemptive mission. But using no weapons other than the Scripture, Jesus repelled Satan's attacks and sent him scurrying away in defeat (Luke 4:1-13).
- The devil makes two more attempts on Jesus' life. He incited Nazareth's leaders to throw Him off a cliff (Luke 4:29) and the Pharisees to stone Him (John 8:59). Jesus miraculously escapes both attempts.
- Finally, however, Satan succeeded. On Friday before the Jewish Passover celebration, the hatred he infused into the hearts of the Jewish leaders finally paid off. He watched in gleeful triumph as they beat Jesus unmercifully and nailed His battered body to a cross to die. When His body was sealed within a tomb, Satan's victory was complete (or so he thought). He did not realize that Jesus' death was but a prelude to His resurrection—the event that would ensure Satan's ultimate doom."
